January—receive letter with 4K Program information

February—complete and return all 4K registration forms, which includes: 4K registration form, District enrollment forms, ASQ-3 Developmental Review, copy of Birth Certificate, copy of immunization records

June—receive 4K placement letter

July—receive letter with directions regarding mandatory on-line registration

August—attendance site 4K visitation. You will be contacted by building/assigned teacher.

September—first day of school.

Guiding Framework for 4K Program

4 year old kindergarten...

- Is a developmentally appropriate, literacy-based program. In a literacy/print rich, play-based environment, children will have opportunities for dialogue, social interaction, dramatic play, listening, and writing.
- Will involve community resources whenever available and appropriate.
- Provides an environment that allows students opportunities for many choices of hands-on, independent as well as small and large group activities—a learning environment that emphasizes the process rather than the product.
- Provides a nurturing environment with clear guidelines. This helps students feel secure and allows for a daily schedule and routine that children and parents rely on each day.
- Provides opportunities and resources for parents and families to support their child's early education.
- Provides a classroom with a variety of materials and centers. Activities will be differentiated to meet the needs of students at all developmental levels.
- Meets the State of Wisconsin guidelines for early learning. Staff at each site will participate in professional development activities and follow shared curricular guidelines.

Why should a community offer quality learning experiences to four-year-olds?

Research shows that quality preschools...

Help children...

- Build the academic, social and emotional skills needed to succeed in school.
- Overcome learning problems and delinquent behavior as they grow older.

Help schools and communities...

- Close the achievement gap of young children as they begin school.
- Streamline and coordinate services for young children and families.
- Engage parents and community members in supporting children's learning.

Age Requirement

Children must be 4 years of age on or before September 1 of the school year.

Both sessions run Monday through Friday and follow the district calendar.
