

# Batting Cage Rules & Guidelines

1. Use of the batting cages is on a reservation basis. To reserve the batting cages, teams and/or individuals must make the request in the rschool facility calendar.
  - a. Reservations can be made in **1.5 hr increments**.
  - b. Online calendar for reservations found at website below:

  - c. Recreation Department will reserve the right, if so necessary, to cancel a reservation. Notification will be attempted in a timely manner, but cannot guarantee advance notice of changes.
2. During scheduled games, the batting cages are reserved for the playing teams only.
3. During non scheduled games, players must **stay off of the playing field**. This includes infield and outfield.
4. No metal cleats are allowed in the batting cages, unless it is during a scheduled game.
5. Only 2 people are permitted inside each cage at one time. The batter and the pitcher.
6. All batters **MUST** wear a helmet.
7. All pitchers **MUST** use the protective pitching screen (L screen) during batting practice.
8. All users of the batting cage understand they use the facility at their own risk.
9. **NO FOOD OR DRINK** permitted in the batting cage. All users are expected to keep the batting cages clean and free of litter at all times.
10. Teams and/or individuals found violating rules may lose batting cage privileges.
