SCHOOL PROFILE

The Sauk Prairie School District includes the twin cities of Sauk City & Prairie du Sac with a total population of approximately 6000. These rural communities are agriculturally oriented. However, many residents commute to professional positions in Madison, 25 southeast of the district.

Testing Program

- 1) Aspire testing- 9th and 10th graders.
- 2) Wisconsin Knowledge and Concepts Exam- 10th graders.
- 3) PSAT (CEEB) is available to interested juniors.
- 4) ACT – 11th graders.
- 5) Workkeys- 11th graders.
- 6) The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery is available on a voluntary basis for interested Juniors and Seniors.

Marking Periods

The academic year is divided into four 9-week quarters. Quarter grades are averaged to yield semester grades. All courses meet every day of the week and generate 1 credit toward the 24 needed for graduation (semester courses generate .5 credit).

Class of 2017 and beyond will need 3 credits of Math and Science and 9 credits of Electives for graduation.

Approximately 50% of our seniors attend a four-year college and 25% attend a two-year program.

Marking System

Class rank: A complete ranking of all students in a class is calculated at the end of each semester.

Advanced Placement Courses

At Sauk Prairie High School advanced placement courses are designed for the college bound student. Students successfully completing AP courses are eligible to take an exam which may result in receiving college credit at some universities. Advanced Placement courses are also weighted.

AP English Language and Composition, AP Biology, AP Calculus, AP Chemistry, AP Computer Science, AP European History, AP Physics, AP Psychology, AP Statistics, AP Studio Art: Drawing & 2D Design, AP Studio Art: 3D Design, and AP United States History.
