KINDERPREP



KinderPrep is an afternoon program at the Community Center designed to offer parents an opportunity for their 4-year old enrolled in Sauk Prairie School District 4K to continue their educational experience and fill the traditional school day. Lunch will be provided through the district hot lunch program.

The KinderPrep program is available only on days when school is in session. Part-time openings limited. Priority will be given to full-time students.

Physical	using fine and gross motor skills

Daily Schedule

2:30-2:45	Daily Wrap-Up. Prepare for parent pick-up or bus to Bridges Elementary or After School Club

Closing/Cancelations/PLC Early Release Days

- When the Sauk Prairie School District cancels school, the KinderPrep program is canceled.
- When Sauk Prairie School District closes school early, KinderPrep program hours will be dependent on release time due to busing.
- When Sauk Prairie School District has a delayed start and the 4K programs are canceled, the KinderPrep program is canceled.
- When there is a scheduled early release day and there is NO district 4K programs, KinderPrep will be closed.

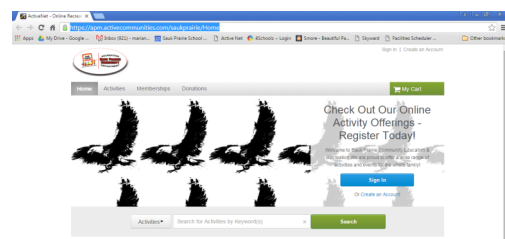
Classroom Visits/Field Trips

- Volunteers must complete a Volunteer form (available on the school district website) including a background check.
- Volunteers must also have prior approval from the teacher or Community Ed Director

How to Register

Registration for the KinderPrep program is done online. You must have an account to register.

1. Go to the Sauk Prairie School District Website.
2. Click on Community Programs.
3. Choose KinderPrep from the left side menu
4. Click on Registration on the right hand side menu. This will take you to **ActiveNet** registration system.
5. If you do not have an ActiveNet account, you will need to create one. If you have an account go to step 7.
6. To create an account, first enter yourself as the adult or guardian. Then save and add each child as an additional family member.
7. Once you have logged in, you can search for the KinderPrep activity and choose the option you want. Add the activity to your cart, and select your child's name as the participant.



The \$35 fee is due at the time of enrollment. If you do not wish to pay online, you can enroll in person at the Community Center. Checks should be made payable to Sauk Prairie Schools. We have a secure drop box located outside of the building for your convenience.
