

Thinking about retirement??

Teachers if you are thinking about retiring there are a few things you should know:

1. Must be age 55 or older.
2. Must have worked in the district for 15 years to continue health insurance benefits and have sick days paid out.
3. Check with Brenda Schlough to find out years of service (FTE).
4. Benefits end August 31st.
5. Go to the ETF website to calculate retirement benefits.

6. Go to the Social Security calculator(if applicable) ssa.gov/planners/benefitcalculator.html
7. Write letter of retirement and send to Superintendent by March 1st.
8. Contact ETF to set up meeting. 877-533-5020
9. Cannot work or apply for jobs in the district for 75 days.
